



### **Mt. Hood Meadows – Passenger Code of Conduct**

1. Building and maintaining strong relationships with the businesses and residents near our bus stops is essential for us to continue to use those areas for our bus stops. All of us are a part of maintaining those positive relationships. Here are some ways you can help be a good neighbor.
  - a. Park only in approved parking spaces – see parking maps for clarification
  - b. No loitering
  - c. Be quiet as residents nearby may be sleeping
  - d. No littering
  - e. No alcohol
2. Be on-time! The employee bus will **DEPART** each stop at the time listed on bus schedule.
  - a. In order to keep our bus on schedule, please arrive at the bus stop a few minutes early. The bus is scheduled to depart each stop at the time on the schedule. It should arrive at each stop a few minutes early to allow enough time for people to board the bus and find a seat.
3. Ride-share to the bus stop – check out [www.drivelessconnect.com](http://www.drivelessconnect.com) to find ride matches
  - a. Parking spots are limited at our park and ride locations. They fill up quickly and the more that we can encourage people to ride share, the more likely it is that everyone will be able to find an available parking spot.
4. Be respectful of others on the bus
  - a. Follow bus drivers instructions and encourage others to do the same
  - b. Use headphones and keep volume low when using personal electronic devices
  - c. Use appropriate language and keep conversation topics PG
  - d. Use the bus only on scheduled work days
  - e. No smoking on the employee bus
